Technical Committee Report – December 2024

The year is quickly winding down and Tech Committee activity has slowed in anticipation of the new officers taking over. As was discussed at the November meeting, the Tech Committee acquired 2 new bulkhead connectors to replace the worn connectors on the counter in the Emergency Communications Center. These will be installed by the end of the year.

As I approach the end of a two-year stint as Tech Committee Chair, I would like to thank all who have helped me through the many tasks at hand. We started with simple upgrades to the tower trailer, installed the bulkhead connectors in the ECC, and insured that everything was properly grounded. Next came the replacement of the FT-897 and the FT-920 with a new FT-991A. We installed a 160M off-center fed dipole on the new tower at the Health Department building and acquired an auto-tuning all-band antenna for the FT-991A. Field Day, Winter Field Day, and Parks on the Air helped us devise a new configuration for the half wave end fed that proved to be a solid performer. In the coming year I will continue to work on a hinge system for the tower trailer to make it easier to deploy. I still have some fabrication to complete. I am sure there will be other projects I can assist with.

I would like to thank Jeff Stewert and Charlie Dixion, the other elected Tech Committee members, for their work and support. I also need to acknowledge Ferrin Nice, who can set up a ladder and be up on the roof before I have time to think about it. This has been a team effort, thank you all for your support.


